Accommodation at the Reserve

The Huilo Huilo Biological Reserve has a variety of accommodation options; hotels, mountain lodges, cabins, apartments, tree houses, backpacker hostels and camping sites. At our hotels visitors will discover a bevy of programs, from all-inclusive such as “Immensity”, and full bed & board plus excursions such as “Essential”, to Half Board and Bed & Breakfast with self-guided tour packages.

Huilo Huilo Half Board Program

The Half Board program was created for those who prefer to reserve and program their excursions and have at least one of their meals at the Reserve. The program includes a pack of self-guided activities, access to the Spa, breakfast, and lunch or dinner, the latter a choice guests can make each day of their stay.



The **Huilo Huilo Half Board Program** includes breakfast service and lunch or dinner (1 service of the two each day chosen on the day), a pack of self-guided activities and access to the Spa. All additional services (transport, excursions and meals) can be reserved directly at the Reserve. Said program is available at the Montaña Mágica Lodge, Nothofagus Hotel and Reino Fungi Lodge with accommodation standards varying according to lodge and room you have chosen for your holiday package.


Activities and excursions





Not-included Guided Excursions

(Must be booked directly at the Excursion Center):

Trekking: Night trek on the Huilo Huilo trail, night trek on the Spirits trail, Botany trail, Magnetic rocks, Volcanic caves, Los Planchados, Mocho slopes, Truful.

Educational excursions: Organic tour, Heritage tour, Mapuche Traditions and Culture tour.

Mountain Bike: Trarolafkén lagoon, Port Fuy, Pudu, rent-a-bike.

Horse rides: Tranca del Toro, the Mañío, las Lengas lookout, Los Pioneros, Maderero, Pony rides.

Canopy: Child "Flight of the Chucao", Huilo Huilo "Flight of the Eagle", XL "Flight of the Condor".

Water Adventure, Kayak journeys, boat expeditions on lake Pirehueico, rafting on the river Fuy, Floating on River Fuy, Floating Río Fuy (family outing).





Adolescents: 13 to 17 years old (adult rates)


About rates

Half Board Program

Itinerary changes

Weather in the Chilean Patagonia can be fickle, even more so in the mountain areas which is precisely where the Bio-reserve Huilo Huilo is located. In the event the weather or other external factor forces a change to the itinerary, such as modifications or cancellations of activities or services included in the program, the company reserves the right to do so without incurring extra costs or giving discounts. We have a wide variety of activities and excursions to offer in the event this should occur, ensuring our guests enjoy their stay at the Reserve.

Transport

The half board program doesn't have a transport service. All self-guided activities include in the program do not consider or include transport to each location; some of said activities are close to the hotel center.



Weather

The Patagonian temperate rainforest is located on Chilean territory, between latitude 38°30'S to 55°30'S, west of the Andes mountains. It is known for abundant rain the year round and its more temperate summers (hot days reach 30°C). This rainy climate is a result of the humidity blown in by anticyclone winds from the South Pacific which condense thanks to the cold Humboldt current running up the coast. Once it blows over the continent and falls as rain until it hits the Andes Mountains where it dissipates as it collides with dry winds from the Patagonian steppes in Argentina.

Physically Demanding

The Huilo Huilo Half Board program includes a pack of self-guided activities. To participate in these activities you don't need to exert strenuous amounts of effort, they are all considered low difficulty. Despite the previous it's always important to walk carefully down trails and walkways; the wet wood and roots that poke out of the forest floor can cause trekkers to trip and fall.

If you have a special condition that may be considered an impediment or problematic to doing to program we ask that you make sure before making a reservation to avoid any possible inconveniences.

What you mustn't forget

It's very important to come prepared for winter and summer on all trips to the reserve. It's important to bring a comfortable backpack for trekking (minimum 3 liters), trekking shoes, a wind-breaker, parka, comfortable pants for walking, a bathing suit, camera, front torchlight, sunblock, sunglasses, enough changes of clothes for rainy days, hat, baseball cap and/or bandana.

It's important to bring cash should you wish to buy souvenirs. Many hotel services have a credit card system however there are no ATMs for cash withdrawals, should you wish to buy from arts and crafts vendors or other cash only stores.
