Nestled on a ridge on the banks of the Zambezi River, Kayila offers sweeping views of the Mana Pools National Park. The camp has a beautiful outdoor lounge area that overlooks the deck and swimming pool, providing a unique vantage point to experience the magic of the Zambezi.


What makes Kayila different?

Kayila Camp sits on the vast 8,700-acre Kayila Private Game Reserve within the Lower Zambezi Conservation area. This is the place where the Big Four, our most frequent and treasured guests, call home. Kayila Private Game Reserve is located where the Zambezi escarpment meets the Zambezi River. Spectacular views abound at the point where the towering hills touch the river.



Our prime location also provides unique insights into the Chiawa/ Magurumenu cultures at the neighbouring village communities. Anabezi, Amanzi and Kayila assist with the protection of the Chiawa GMA and the development of these communities through the Zambezi Wildlife Trust.

Kayila is an excellent starting point for groups that want to experience more of the Zambezi Valley. The camp offers a plethora of activities: from game drives through the Private Reserve and walks through the property including our famous "River to Ridge", to sunsets and camp-outs on the escarpment at Farley's Foundations.



Walking Safaris

For a change of pace from the 4WD game drive, choose a scenic walk around the endless plains. Accompany trackers by foot on the trail of wildlife, and learn about local flora and fauna as you go. Kayila offers a network of walking trails of varying distances and degrees of difficulty: from the 3km "Zambezi Wonder" that starts from the camp up the banks of the Lower Zambezi, to the 5 hour "Escarpment Summit" and everything in between.

Camp-Out at Farley's Foundations

Wilderness trails from Kayila take you into the heart of the untamed veld at Farley's Foundations. From this lofty site 100m up on the escarpment, guests can enjoy panoramic views of the river, and an authentic experience camping in the African bush and sleeping beneath the stars.

Lunch at Chimusambo Village

Guests are invited to enjoy a traditional lunch in Chimusambo village. Sit down to a hearty meal of Nshima and freshly-caught Fish. Learn more about life in a Zambian village and embark on a tour of Chimusambo village with the local Headman.
