

# Cultural tours through Bouddi National Park

Experience a guided bush walk through the national park based on your fitness level and how far you would like to hike. These walks are a complete sensory experience including information on local flora & fauna, medicinal plants, traditional bush tucker, storytelling and indigenous activities. Includes viewings of indigenous art and carvings and some of the peninsula's most sacred sites.

See the extraordinary coastal sandstone cliffs, discover hidden beaches and immerse yourself in the wonders of nature as you meander along our stunning coastline.

We can pack you a picnic lunch, and there are plenty of photo opportunities around every bend. Wildflowers are blooming in Spring (September to November) and you may even see a migrating whale - May to July heading north or September to October heading south for the Summer. You may even like to take your bathing costume for a dip in the salty ocean which contains many vital elements for the human body including high levels of magnesium to reduce stress, relax muscles, induce calmness and promote deep sleep.

The following walks and tours have been formally approved by NSW National Parks and endorsed by the Darkinjung Land Council and the Guringai Tribal Link Aboriginal Corporation.

## **Box Head**

1-2 hour Guided Cultural Tour

Around the property and to Box Head and back

\$330 for 2-8 adults

## **Tallow Beach**

2-3 hour Guided Cultural Tour

Around the property to Tallow Beach and back

\$440 for 2-8 adults

## **Further afield**

2-4 hour Cultural Bushcraft Experience

This unforgettable experience includes viewings of Indigenous sites, information on edible/medicinal wild plants, a didgeridoo lesson and also a traditional fire-making session. This tour may include offsite locations, including the Bouddi Coastal Track. The Coastal Track runs from Putty Beach to MacMasters Beach. Boasting beaches, boardwalks and birdlife, it's known as one of the most beautiful walks in the area. This relatively easy hike is characterised by sweeping views, shady rainforest and spectacular sandstone cliffs. This tour is tailored to suit fitness and ability and can be suitably personalised.

All tours and experiences must be pre-booked. Cancellation policy: Full charges will apply unless more than 24 hour notice of any cancellation is received. In the case of inclement weather, walks may need to be rescheduled, postponed or cancelled. Other cultural activities such as dances and acknowledgement ceremonies can be held in any weather. Experiences are not available on public holidays. Prices include GST and are in Australian dollars.

## ONSITE Indigenous Experiences

These are interactive, personal and educational experiences allowing guests to join in (if you please) and learn corroboree dances and songs, incorporating the famous wind instrument developed by Indigenous Australians.

## OFFSITE Wildlife Experiences

### **The Australian Walkabout Wildlife Park**

Once in a lifetime experience and a must for International guests!

Only 40 mins drive from PBH, you will pat & hold Australian wildlife in the Aussie bush with your own personal park ranger. Get up close and personal with the emus, kangaroos, echidnas and koalas that are waiting for you at the fabulous animal sanctuary. Most of the animals at this park are not caged in so it's an opportunity to experience the animals first hand - patting and holding is encouraged! Learn about bush tucker and bush medicine and sit amongst the animals whilst you enjoy your snacks including delicious damper, bush jams and refreshments.

2 hours private tour with ranger \$200 per person (min 2 pax)

### **Glenworth Valley Outdoor Adventure Park**

- Horse riding (2 hours) \$95pp

#### Transfers

- Luxury car transfer to/from PBH (40 mins) \$200 return

- Helicopter from Sydney to Glenworth Valley or Wildlife Park, Car to PBH \$1,600
- Helicopter from Sydney to PBH with stopover at Glenworth Valley or Wildlife Park \$2,500

- Kayak Hire \$30 for 1 hour hire of single, \$40 for 1 hour hire of double
- Paddleboard Hire \$35 for 1 hour

### **Wine country**

Hunter Valley Day Trip with a visit to Walkabout Wildlife Park, then drive via the old convict route, stopping at historic Australian Wollombi Pub. Lunch at magnificent Bistro Molines at Mount View (at own expense) and visiting 3 top Australian wineries for private tastings, before heading back to the coast. \$400 per person (minimum 2 pax)
