LOCATION

WILDLIFE ACTIVITIES AND GAME DRIVES

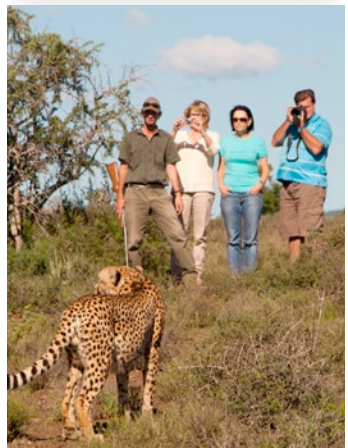
Wildlife and Teambuilding activities

- Morning game drive: an early morning drive with a tea and coffee stop.
- Sundowner game drive: a late afternoon game drive with an interval for sundowners. For optimal viewing, a powerful spotlight is used when night falls.
- Night drive: depart after dinner. Experience the night coming alive, who knows you might even get to follow the lions.
- Cosmic safari: an interesting and intriguing journey into the Africa night skies (dependent on weather conditions).
- Khoisan cave walk: a 2 hour excursion to view some newly discovered San/Bushman paintings. These have been dated back 400 years (this walk is physically challenging as it requires climbing).
- Nature walks: explore the Karoo on foot. Learning about nature and wildlife up close and personal (max 12 people per 2 guides).
- Wild Fly Fishing
Catch and release the elusive small mouth Yellow Fish as part of a fishing clinic with all gear supplied or bring your own gear and enjoy the serenity on offer. Pre-booking essential.
- 4x4 Trail
This is a great opportunity for a teambuilding exercise, experiencing breathtaking views while trying your hand at 4x4 driving. Pre-booking essential.

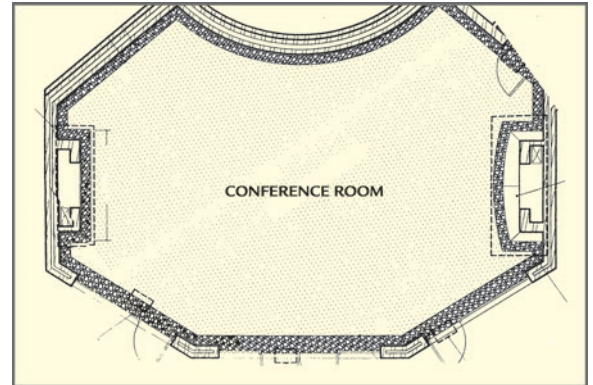
LOCATION

Both the Lion conference room and smaller Cheetah boardroom boast a spectacular view of the Winterberg Mountains as back drop. Although the seclusion of the lodge might make it seem removed from the civilization, it has all the amenities a corporate conference, product launch or a strategic planning session may require. Meeting every desire of the modern business traveller including a business centre offering printing and photocopy facilities with unlimited wireless internet connectivity.

The Lion Room seats up to 48 delegates cinema style and is equipped with two pull down screens, a white board, flip chart, a data projector and sound system as well as wireless internet access and data points.

The Cheetah Boardroom lends itself to either a separate venue for a private meeting, dining or breakaway area.

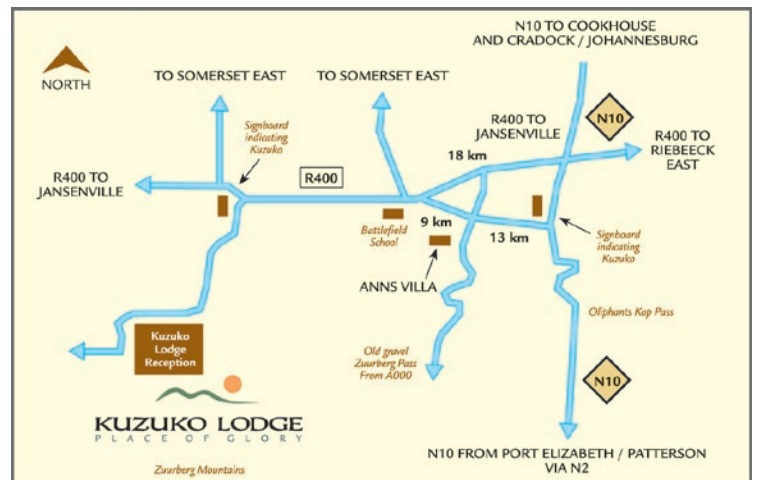

DIRECTIONS FROM PORT ELIZABETH TO KUZUKO LODGE

- From the airport, take the N2 towards Grahamstown.
- Continue for approximately 60km the road forks, carry straight on, along the N10, do not take the turn off to the N2.
- Continue past the turn-off to Nanaga Farm Stall.
- After 21km continue past the town of Paterson and pass over the Olifantskop Mountain Pass.
- Continue past the Ann's Villa turn-off for a further 11km.
- Turn left at an old shop - Oom Teuns se Winkel Signage reads (R400) Jansenville / Riebeeckstad & Grahamstown.
- There is a Kuzuko sign in the mouth of the turn
- Follow the R400 to Bracefield - T-Junction.
- Turn right as the Kuzuko sign directs - 23 km.
- Keep left as the road forks following the Kuzuko sign boards.
- Continue for approximately 10km till the sign board stating Kuzuko 11 km, turn left here.
- The road gets narrower now, after 11km you will come to the Kuzuko Reception building This is a Cape style white house used as a welcome & educational centre.
- Proceed to park your car undercover. Our game rangers are waiting here to whisk you off to our 5 star lodge.
