Rhino tracking adventure at Phinda



Forgo an early morning game drive and spend an unforgettable morning tracking a rare and highly endangered species on foot.

Groups of up to six guests can experience the thrill of tracking black rhino on foot, accompanied throughout by an armed ranger and tracker team in a private safari vehicle.

Learn how to follow rhino tracks, recognise rhino middens and scratching posts, and follow the signs of the trees and grasses searching for rhino in the company of Phinda's experts.

This exhilarating experience, which is booked from any of **andBeyond** Phinda Private Game Reserve's lodges, takes the place of one of the interpretive morning game drives. It lasts four hours and provides guests with a unique chance for an intimate encounter with one of Africa's rarest, most endangered animals.

The safety of our guests is paramount and only the most expertly trained and qualified **andBeyond** guides host these walks. Our professional walking guides are renowned in the industry, and each hold level 2 certification and a minimum of two years' experience. All specialist guides must have completed a certain number of walks into big game before qualifying as an **andBeyond** walking guide.

The rhino is now classified as a critically endangered species and Phinda remains committed to ensuring its survival.
