HOW TO GET THERE

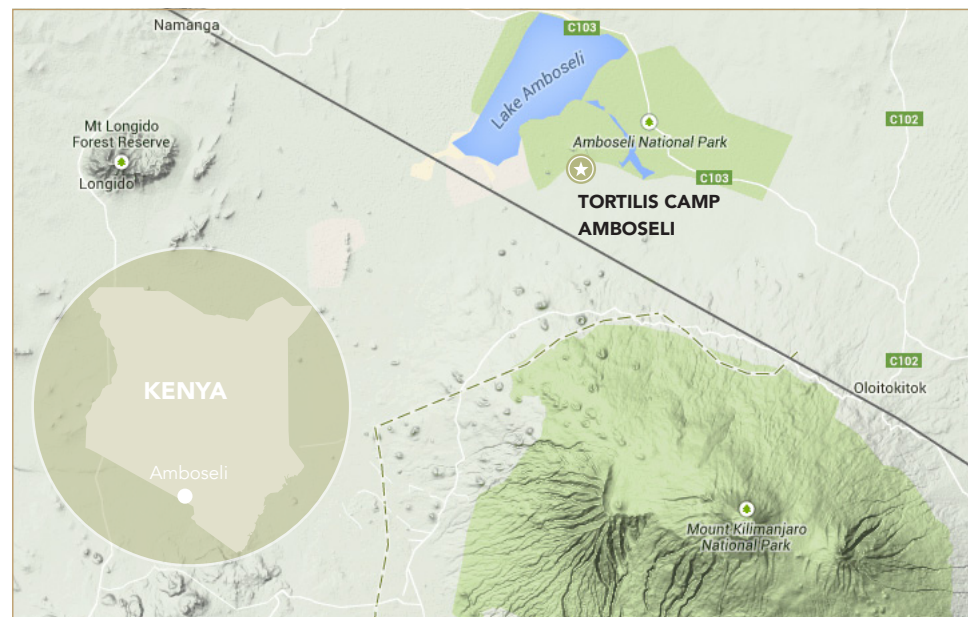
Amboseli airstrip is a 45-minute drive from the camp.

- Daily scheduled Safarilink flights departing Nairobi Wilson at 08h15 and 14h00*
- Once daily scheduled Mombasa Air flight departing Mombasa at 07h30
- Once daily scheduled Mombasa Air flight departing the Masai Mara at 14h00
- Private charter from anywhere

LOCATION

ELECTRICITY

- Tortilis Camp runs on 100% solar. One generator in place for emergency
- All tents have power 24 hours a day for lighting
- Guest batteries can be charged in the tents and at the bar
- All game-viewing vehicles have inverters allowing battery charging whilst on game drives
- All tents run on a solar inverter system, which cannot support hair dryers. A hairdryer can be obtained from the bar, for use at the swimming pool changing area only
- Guests are recommended to bring converters & universal plug adaptors
