MVUU CAMP



Mvuu Camp has a spectacular vantage on the banks of the Shire River. The river is a magnet for wildlife and draws an abundance of fauna to its banks. The camp, comprising 12 units as well as a nearby campsite, is a mix of spacious stone and canvas chalets and specially designed family tents.

An impressive thatched dining and lounge area offers a magnificent river vista that is framed by two large baobab trees. Dinners are sometimes held under the stars in a specially constructed boma. A custom-built education and conference centre with facilities for up to 40 delegates or smaller corporate and team building functions is available.

Mvuu Camp offers a variety of activities including boat safaris on the Shire River, game drives, guided walks and non-stop birding. Game drives through the ESOM rhino sanctuary and trips to nearby villages and Nanthomba School are also popular. On request, guests can also visit one of our resident conservation projects to experience life as a wildlife researcher.
