FACT SHEET FOR CAMP CECIL DE LA SIERRA

The Tents

Camp Cecil de la Sierra features four beautifully decorated walk-in tents. Each tent is 12' x 16' and has real beds, lovely linens, rugs, bedside tables with lamps, lanterns, towels, yoga mats, fans, storage space, chairs, and a covered patio with rocking chairs. The headboards, tables, cabinets and rocking chairs are all handcrafted by a local carpenter. Each tent has a compost toilet cabaña attached. Tents can have either one king bed or two twin beds.

The Shower

The Camp has a hotel-quality shower equipped with a solar water heater that produces plenty of hot water with good pressure. It is decorated with

The Food

All meals from lunch on the first day through breakfast on the final day are included in your stay at Camp Cecil de la Sierra. Daily happy hour too! All food is prepared in the camp's traditional ranch kitchen using a wood-fired brick stove. All meats, cheese and tortillas are provided by the ranchers and the vegetables and herbs come from Camp Cecil Farms on the same property.

The Adventures

Activities at Camp Cecil de la Sierra include hiking, bird watching, star gazing and workshops on traditional ranch skills such as leather working and candy and tortilla making.

The Guides

You will be accompanied by one of our wonderful bilingual naturalist guides during your entire stay at Camp Cecil de la Sierra. TOSEA guides are all certified Wilderness First Responders, NOM-9 graduates, and are Leave No Trace certified.

Insurance

Delays and Weather Events

The cost of delays is not included if any trip is delayed or cancelled due to bad weather, trail conditions, road conditions, transportation delays, government intervention, sickness or other contingency for which Todos Santos Eco Adventures or its agents cannot make provision. If you are unable to get to Camp Cecil de la Sierra due to a weather event, you can apply your payment to a future stay but there are no refunds for weather problems.

Reservation and Cancellation Policies

A 10% deposit is required to hold a reservation and is fully refundable up to 60 days prior to the start date of your trip. Full payment is required 60 days prior to the start date of your trip. This payment is non-refundable, so all travelers are strongly advised to purchase travel insurance. If you or TOSEA has to cancel your trip due to COVID-19 travel restrictions, your full payment will be applied to a future stay any time within the 48 months following the date of your original reservation. The same rates as your original reservation will apply.

COVID-19

TOSEA and our staff members have achieved the following certifications for our hard work on safety and hygiene measures:

- Accreditation with COEPRIS, the State Commission for Protection against Sanitary Risk

- Our Operations and Office Protocols meet the Safe Travels official stamp requirements laid out by the WTTC (World Travel & Tourism Council)
- All TOSEA guides, chefs, camp managers, housekeepers, drivers and kitchen staff have completed COVID-19 training with IMSS (Mexican Institute of Social Security)
- All TOSEA guides, chefs, and bodega managers have completed COVID-19 training with the WHO (World Health Organization) and all guides have completed advanced COVID-19 training with SSA (Mexico's Health Secretariat)
