

## self-drive directions

### From Johannesburg

The driving time from Johannesburg to Cape Vulture Conservancy is about 4.5 to 5 hours.

The distance is approximately 400 km.

- Depart O.R. Tambo International Airport following the airport exit signs (R21 Pretoria / R24 Johannesburg).
- Take exit 429A for Rondebuit Road N12 toward eMalahleni.
- Take the N12/N4 from Johannesburg via eMalahleni and Middleburg towards Nelspruit.
- Turn left on the R540 towards eMakhazeni (Belfast).
- In centre of town turn right Steven Masango Street/R540 to eMnotweni (Dullstroom) and then on to Mashishing (Lydenburg).
- Pass through Mashishing (Lydenburg) taking the R36 to Ohrigstad, through the Strijdom Tunnel to Hoedspruit.
- When exiting the Strijdom Tunnel, drive for 10km. You'll find the main gate on your right hand side. (If you drove past the Total garage on your left hand side, you're too far.)

### please note

These routes are safe to drive. You will pass through rural areas where the local people are friendly. Please drive carefully, and be aware of village pedestrians, children, and domestic animals on the road. Enjoy the magnificent views. Before entering the Strijdom Tunnel you might stop for a moment to enjoy the Mermaid waterfall.
