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ABOUT ENASOIT

Enasoit is a private wildlife reserve and permanent tented camp nestled in the foothills of Mount Kenya, surrounded by pristine wilderness. Guests enjoy the camp as well as the wildlife reserve on a purely exclusive-use basis – an ideal retreat for families and groups of friends. As a small and intimate camp, Enasoit has unique charm. It is relaxed and welcoming, yet luxurious and beautifully appointed. An Enasoit safari offers remarkable wildlife encounters and an array of exciting ways to experience the wilderness. One of the most distinctive features of Enasoit Camp is the extraordinary wildlife activity at the waterhole just in front of the main Mess Tent – the perfect viewpoint for game-viewing from the comfort of an armchair.

UNIQUE FEATURES

- **Complete exclusivity** – exclusive use of Enasoit Camp and the 4,500 acre wildlife reserve; and access to adjoining 50,000 acre wildlife reserve
- **Proximity to wildlife** – the busy waterhole at camp attracts a huge amount of activity daily
- **Safari activities included** – night drives, bush dinners, walks, horse-riding, massages
- **Friendly, attentive staff** – service with a personal touch, which makes you feel part of the family
- **Ideal for group safaris** – the perfect spot for multi-generational trips and milestone celebrations

ACCOMMODATION

Enasoit Camp has 8 rooms in total: 6 rooms at Enasoit Camp and 2 rooms at the Pool House.

THE CAMP

Enasoit Camp's 6 tented cottages are situated around the waterhole, which attracts a busy array of wildlife, easily visible from the tent verandahs. Elephant, giraffe, buffalo and many species of antelope regularly come to drink, and lion and cheetah often wander past Camp. The tents are carefully constructed using canvas and local materials, combining the romance of living 'under canvas' with the comfort of a permanent structure. Each tent has an en-suite bathroom, wooden floors, a sitting area with a fireplace and private verandah.

Life in camp revolves around the open-sided Mess Tent, which overlooks the waterhole. By day, the Mess Tent offers a comfortable shaded spot from which to enjoy the wildlife and views across the plain. At night, a campfire is lit in front of the Mess Tent for pre-dinner drinks and sightings of Enasoit's nocturnal wildlife.

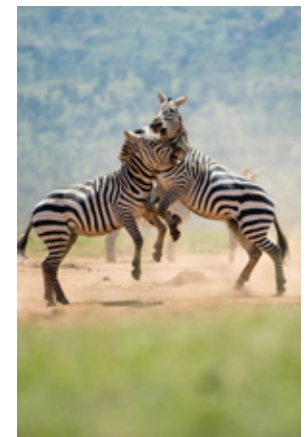
THE POOL HOUSE

The Pool House is located on a small hillside just 5 minutes drive or 20 minute gentle walk from Enasoit Camp. The Pool House has two thatched double en-suite cottages, as well as a sitting and dining room set beside the pool, and it is surrounded by tropical gardens with exceptional bird life. The Pool House provides additional accommodation for larger groups and is also an alternative location for lunches and dinners, or for tranquil afternoons relaxing by the pool.

LOCATION

Enasoit is located in Laikipia in central Kenya - a rich and diverse natural treasure, boasting some of Africa's most extraordinary and endangered wildlife and vast, pristine wilderness areas. Set against the backdrop of Mount Kenya, the Laikipia plateau extends over 9,500 sq km of ever-changing, diverse landscapes - from semi-arid plains, dramatic gorges, rocky outcrops and rolling acacia-covered hills.

This area has become one of the most important areas for wildlife in Kenya, boasting wildlife density and biodiversity second only to that found in the Masai Mara. It's here where some of the most effective conservation work in the country is being done, and where Enasoit Camp is found.

The location of Enasoit Camp is exceptional. The Camp and private wildlife reserve sits within a natural wildlife corridor, and is a haven for game-viewing and the bird-life is some of the most vibrant and varied in Kenya. Guests can explore the reserve on horseback, on foot or by vehicle, or simply watch the wildlife wander past from their verandah - enjoying both the tranquility and thrill of a safari without seeing any other visitors.

CAPACITY

Enasoit Camp can accommodate 16 guests in 6 tented cottages and 2 thatched cottages at the Pool House. Additional capacity for larger groups can be arranged and extra beds for children are available.

Enasoit Camp is booked on an exclusive use basis only – the wildlife reserve and the camp are *exclusively yours*.

THE TEAM

Pete and Karen Glover and their team manage the reserve and Camp. Pete and Karen are Kenyan born and live permanently at Enasoit with their two children. Many of our staff have been with us for over 15 years and have a deep knowledge of the area and wildlife.

TIPPING CULTURE

Gratuities are welcomed and greatly appreciated; please speak to the camp managers for advice and procedures.

CHILD RATES

Child rates apply to those aged 5 to 15 years inclusive. Those aged 16 years and above are charged the adult rate. Children 4 years and under stay free of charge.

FOOD AND DIETARY REQUIREMENTS

As Enasoit is a small and exclusive camp, catering for all dietary requirements is possible. Food allergies and dietary requests should be arranged prior to arrival. Delicious, fresh ingredients are sourced locally wherever possible, and the style of cuisine is wholesome home cooking.

CLIMATE AND SEASONS

Enasoit Camp is located on the equator at 6,000 ft, which means days are warm (mid 20's celcius) and mornings and evenings are cooler. The rainy seasons typically fall in the month of April, May and November. January to March are the warmest months, and June to September are a bit cooler.

ACCESS

Enasoit Camp is easily accessed by a 45-minute flight or 4-hour drive from Nairobi. Enasoit has its own airstrip (5 minute drive from Enasoit Camp) where private charter flights can land, and there are daily scheduled flights to Nanyuki (1-hour drive from Enasoit Camp). Guests arriving by helicopter can land directly at Enasoit Camp.

MALARIA PREVENTION

Guests should seek professional medical advice before travelling including advice regarding malaria prophylactics, recommended vaccinations and the relevant travel and medical insurance.

ELECTRICITY AT THE CAMP

There is 24-hour power in Camp, supplied by solar panels and a back-up generator. Guests can charge electric appliances in their rooms, or in the main areas.

WILDLIFE

One of the unique and amazing features of Enasoit Camp is the close proximity to wildlife. Enasoit Camp is an unfenced property on a wildlife conservancy, and as a result guests are advised to always maintain a safe distance from wildlife and not to walk anywhere unaccompanied.
