WILDLIFE CONSERVATION LECTURES

Lion Lecture

A lion lecture provides information on the day to day lives of lions found in and around Mara Naboisho Conservancy. During the lecture, guests learn more about lion population in the Mara and their movements. How to identify lions & lion prides and how to tell their age from characteristics such as the mane, tail & nose.

(USD 50 per person)

Elephant Lecture

An elephant lecture provides information ranging from the different elephant species, elephant lifespan, social hierarchy, population, elephant diet and rituals. Additionally, elephant lectures also provide information on threats facing elephants and how they provide continuity and sustainability of the Savannah.

Hyena Lecture

Hyenas are interesting wildlife to observe and present interesting study materials. During a lecture on hyenas, guests are provided with information on hyena population in Masai Mara, hyena movements, behavior, habitat and how to identify hyena species based on their body patterns, colours, face and shapes.

CHILDREN

Children of all ages are welcome to enjoy our accommodations and safaris under below plan;

- a) Children below 5 years sharing tent with adults, stay free.
- b) Children 5 to 16 years sharing tent with 2 adults, will each be charged 50% of adult sharing per night rate
- c) Children 5 to 16 years sharing own tent will each be charged 75% of per adult sharing per night rate
- d) Children 5 to 16 years sharing tent with one adult pay 50% of adult rate & adult pays full single room rate
- e) Children age limit for Bush Walking Safaris and Dorobo Mobile Camp is 12 years
- f) Children dinner is served at 6.00 pm in all Camps
- g) Child conservation fee at Eagle View, Leopard Hill, Dorobo Mobile Camp, applies from 5 - 16 yrs.
- h) Child Park entry fees at Basecamp Masai Mara and Basecamp Adventure, applies from 3 - 18 yrs

Children are the responsibility of their parents or guardians. Child carers can be organized on request for USD 10 per hour, payable direct.

CANCELLATION

Cancellations are effective on receipt of written notification upon confirmation;

- a) Booking cancelled up to 61 days prior to arrival date, 100% of payment received is refunded.
- b) Bookings cancelled 60 to 45 days prior to arrival date, 20% of the total package amount is retained.
- c) Bookings cancelled 44 to 30 days prior to arrival date, 50% of the total booking amount is retained.
- d) Bookings cancelled 29 days to arrival date, 100% of the total booking amount is retained. Same with No Show.
