



### **Deloraine House Directions**

Deloraine is approximately a 3 ½ - 4 ½ hour drive from Nairobi. (180kms) depending on traffic! Although Deloraine does appear on your google maps please do not follow those directions as will try and take you the wrong way.

Take the Eldoret road out of Nakuru. Drive Approx 30kms and towards the end of the long straight keep on the Main road through Salgaa (which is a lorry stop) keeping on the main road and do no turn right towards Rongai (There is often a police check just before Salgaa so be careful of speeding down the long straight!

Approximately 800 meters after Salgaa, look out for a fork to the right onto the old broken Tarmac road but if you miss it take the next right opposite a lay-by and red and green striped building and turn immediately left back onto the broken old road tarmac.

(It is important not to miss this turn as if you continue on the new road over the bridge and start to climb the hill you will have gone too far and will have to continue for quite some way before you can do a U turn which is very difficult as there is a new wall ).

Continue on the old road over the old Molo River bridge and take first turn right immediately after the bridge at Leldet Primary School sign and that is the Deloraine Gate. There is a Safari Com Mast on the drive which is a good landmark to look out for as you leave Salgaa.

Follow the main drive bearing right and over the dam wall, take first left after dam where the water is over flowing - keep straight on up that road do not take the first right but keep straight on up the hill past the cross country field on your right until you see the garages and big fallen tree on your right take the first right after the loading ramp on your left and drive through garage area and on down to the back parking area behind the house.

NB. Although the drive is generally ok for small cars if wet it can be a bit tricky so best you have good clearance.

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
