### TRAVELLING IN MOZAMBIQUE

- Travellers can apply for the required visas from their home country, for which a Booking Confirmation with the guest name and passport number can be sent upon request.
- Tourist visas are available at all entry points to Mozambique. The current visa cost is 50 USD.
- We advise all parents travelling via South Africa with children to contact their local embassy regarding Unabridged Birth Certificates and laws pertaining to children travelling in and out of South Africa.
- If you are driving a vehicle through the border ensure that your vehicle has:
  - The correct country stickers displayed.
  - The correct items i.e. Safety vests, breakdown triangles, small fire extinguisher, a valid TIP (temporary import permit), logbook and third party insurance.
- When towing boats/trailers, ensure that you have the towing stickers displayed and the correct registration paperwork.
- Both the TIP and the Insurance are obtainable at the border on arrival in Mozambique. Ensure that you have a valid drivers license and if the vehicle does not belong you, you will require a letter of authorization from the owner allowing you to drive and cross a border with a copy of the owners ID /Passport attached to the letter.
- On arrival (air or road) ensure that all your paperwork is correctly stamped on both sides of the border prior to departing customs.
- Mention all items on the TIP (Temporary import permit)
- Please ensure your Park Entrance Ticket is stamped by Anvil Bay before departing for the Park Gate security.

#### What to bring:

- Comfortable light clothing for day time
- Warm, comfortable wear for the evenings, even in summer
- Beach & Bush wear
- Beach sandals for hot sand during November to March.
- Sun screen, sun hat and sun glasses
- Camera, spare batteries and spare memory cards
- A sense of adventure and barefoot relaxation.

### RECOMMENDED CLOTHING

Being humid in Mozambique most of the time, we recommend light cotton clothing - you will more than likely only need your swimwear, sarong, sun hat, sunscreen and sandals for the hot sand. Bring something warm for windy evenings and comfortable walking shoes if you intend partaking in one of our Dune Forest trails. For the rest of your stay shoes are completely optional and no dress codes apply.

### CURRENCY

Mozambican Meticaís and South African Rands are widely accepted in the surrounds of Anvil Bay. We accept Meticaís, Rands, UD Dollars, Euro's and Pounds Sterling in cash as well as Visa & Master Credit Cards. We regret no Diners, American Express cards or cheques.

### MALARIA ADVICE

Mozambique is a malaria country. Anvil Bay is situated in a low risk malaria area; however we would recommend that you consult your travel doctor prior to departing your home country. For your convenience Mosquito repellent is available in your room.

### TRAVEL INSURANCE

Due to the nature and remoteness of the lodge we recommend that all of our guests take out comprehensive travel insurance prior to travelling. We will do everything in our power to ensure smooth transfers and a wonderful stay, but Anvil Bay will not be held liable for any changes to or missing of flights due to weather patterns or any other unforeseen elements.
