



WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW

- Children must always be accompanied by an adult when travelling.
- Guides will always have the final say in whether a child is allowed to join a certain activity.
- If a camp accepts children under 6, they will be accommodated free of charge.
- A 50% discount applies to children between 6 and 18.
- Children aged 19 and over will be charged the full adult rate.
- A private guide/vehicle must be booked for families travelling with children 12 years and younger (*at an additional cost*).
- Please consult your doctor for recommended vaccinations.
- Children's menus are available.

Please inform reservations of any dietary requirements or requests your child may have prior to travel – and confirm upon arrival with the Camp Management.

SAFARIHOEK & ETOSHA MOUNTAIN LODGE

- Safarihoek and Etosha Mountain Lodge accept children of all ages.
- Family suite: two rooms connected by a living room, accommodating a maximum of 2 adults and 2 children. Each room has an ensuite bathroom.
- Twin/double room: a max of two adults and one child sharing per room. A child can be accommodated on a bed roll.
- If the family suite is not available, families travelling with two children under 12 will be roomed as one adult and one child per room.
- If guests are travelling with children 12 years of age and under, a private guide & vehicle is required.
- All activities are available to children of all ages.

SAFARI HOUSE

- Safari House accepts children of all ages.
- The house sleeps a maximum of 9 guests in 3 bedrooms (*6 adults and up to 3 additional children*). Extra charges apply for more than 6 guests.
- A private guide and vehicle are included for the duration of the stay.
- All activities are available to children of all ages.

KWESSI DUNES

- Kwessi Dunes accepts children of all ages.
- 2 x family rooms: two bedrooms, one with a King size bed and one with 2 single beds. Please note that the two rooms share a bathroom.
- Twin/double room: a max of two adults and one child sharing per room. A child can be accommodated on a bed roll.
- If the family suite is not available, families travelling with two children under 12 will be roomed as one adult and one child per room.
- Guests travelling with children 12 years of age and under, a private guide & vehicle is required.
- Only children aged 6 and over 1.2 metres tall may take part in the balloon safaris.
- Only children aged 16 and over may quad bike.

SHIPWRECK LODGE

- Shipwreck Lodge accepts children of all ages.
- Family cabin: accommodates 2 adults and 2 children in a double bed and pull-out bed. Please note that the family cabin is not suitable for 2 children over 12 years of age due to size.
- Twin/double cabin: A max of two adults and one child sharing per cabin.
- A child can be accommodated on a bed roll.
- Children of all ages may participate in the majority of activities under parental supervision, but please note that quad biking is only available to children aged 16 and over.
- Sand boarding is not advisable for very small children (*aged 0 - 4 years*).
- Shipwreck Lodge accommodates a maximum of 20 guests.

HOANIB VALLEY CAMP

- Hoanib Valley Camp accepts children of all ages.
- Family tent: one large tent, with a separate sleeping area for children, accommodating a maximum of two adults and two children.
- Twin/double tent: a max of two adults and one child sharing per tent. A child can be accommodated on a bed roll. If the family tent is not available, families travelling with two children under 12 years of age will be roomed as one adult and one child per tent.
- If guests are travelling with children 12 years of age and under, a private guide & vehicle is required.
- Only children aged 12 years and older may take part in the rhino tracking.
- Only children aged 12 years and older may take part in a walking safari.
- Hoanib Valley Camp accommodates a maximum of 12 guests.
